

Protocol 3: Saving Data

Save the data to Text files for Excel or later analysis

You may use Google Sheets or Microsoft Excel to analyze data, graph results, or produce statistical results, or any software packages of your choice. (You may also draw graphs by hand on graph paper if you prefer).

Save as “Chart data” to save the entire chart record as a text file. The other option is just to save the contents of the data pad as a text file. *Save both so that you can go back to the raw data (Chart data) if you need to.* Open the data pad text file in Google sheets. Install Chart reader software onto your home computer for this purpose.

Saving Chart files for use on a PC (Windows 2000, XP)

You can work with your data in Chart on your PC as long as you save the file in Chart for Windows format. To do this, in the “Save As” menu, select file format “Chart (win)” to save the file with a .adicht suffix.

Install LabChart reader on your home computer so you can analyze data at home. Download the free version of the LabChart software (the reader version) from the ADI website: <https://www.adinstruments.com/products/labchart/versions-and-licenses>
